Social Engineering

(here social science context, not just security context)

Social engineering is a discipline in social science that refers to efforts to influence particular attitudes and social behaviors on a large scale, whether by governments, media or private groups in order to produce desired characteristics in a target population. Social engineering can also be understood philosophically as a deterministic phenomenon where the intentions and goals of the architects of the new social construct are realized.

-> Both contexts interesting to get (policy) results done.


- Worst industrial disaster

- attention for victims




The Burglary: The Discovery of J. Edgar Hoover's Secret FBI



Defense - be aware of various limitations, perceptions & situational awareness

- Media competency (how to check news and facts)
- Filter-bubble
- Gellmann-[Amnesia-Effect](#)
- Election ads (AfD, [Trump](#), ..., advertising general)
- Short-term memory (see financial crisis '08)
- Short- vs. longterm “earnings” - [cookie study](#)
- Time and resources scarcity, and complexity
- ... endless list ... cognitive [dissonance](#) & [biases list](#)



-> leads overload and short cuts

Needed to make halfway usable decisions

Offense global rules [link](#)

- Reciprocation
- Social Proof
- Commitment and Consistency
- Liking
- Authority
- Scarcity
